## About Eurosmart

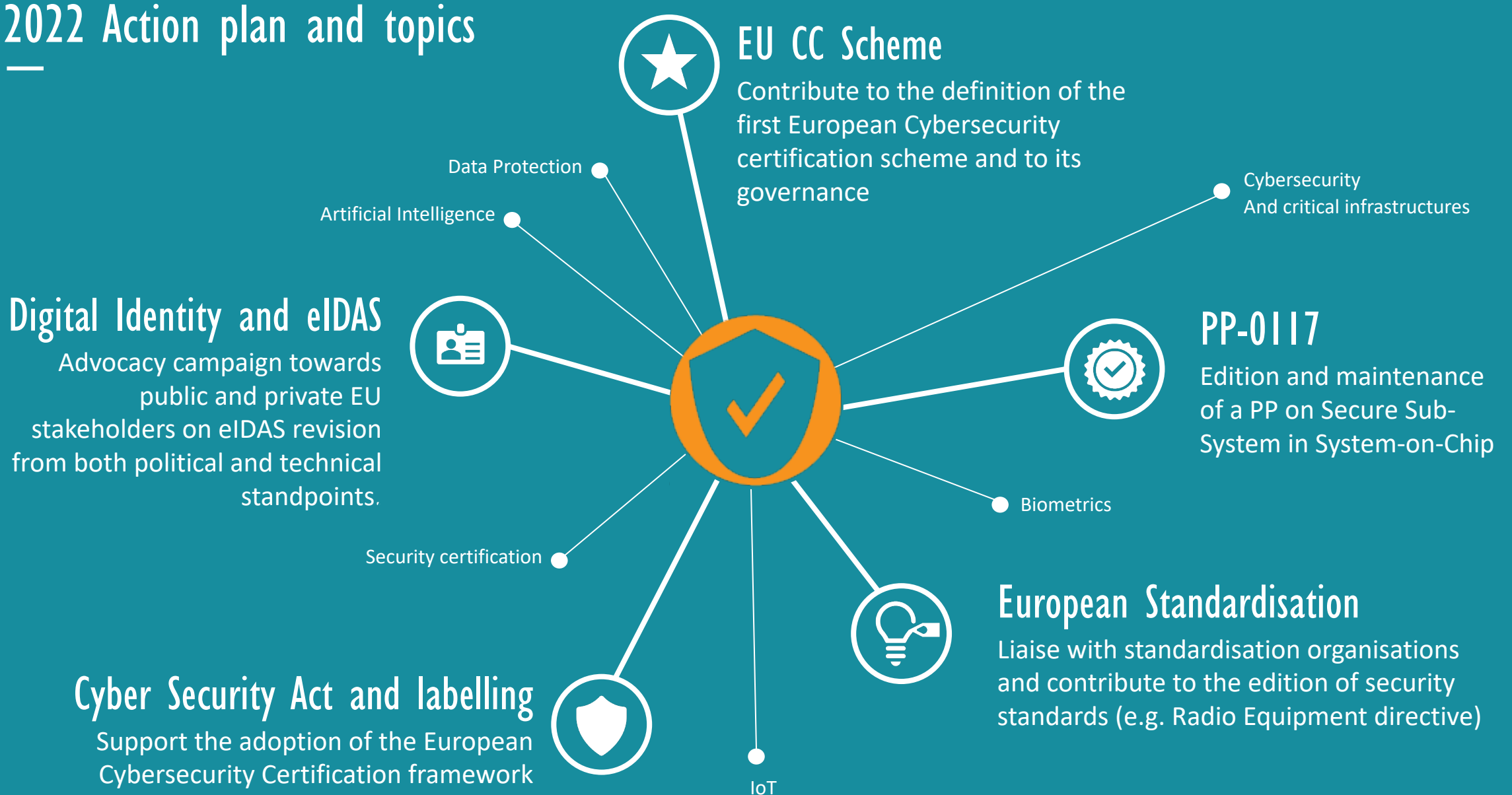
